# Part D Drug List

## **What is the Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia drug list?**

A drug list is a list of drugs (also known as a formulary) approved by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia in consultation with a team of health care providers and other professionals. The prescription therapies listed on the drug list are believed to be an important factor associated with most treatment programs. Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia will generally cover the drugs listed in our drug list as long as the drug is medically necessary, the prescription is filled at a network pharmacy and other plan rules are followed. For more information on how to fill your prescriptions, please review your Evidence of Coverage (EOC). If there is a conflict between this document and the EOC, the terms of the EOC shall control.

## **Can the drug list change?**

Yes, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia may add or remove drugs from our drug list during the year. The enclosed drug list is current as of Jan. 1, 2006. To get updated information about the drugs covered by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia, please visit our Web site at [www.bcbsga.com](http://www.bcbsga.com) or call Customer Service at 1-866-865-9329, Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Eastern. TTY/TDD users should call 1-888-844-5530. If we remove medications from our drug list, add prior authorization restrictions or quantity limits, or move a drug to a higher cost sharing tier, we must notify members who take the drug that it will be removed at least 60 days before the date the change becomes effective, or at the time the member requests a refill of the drug, at which time the member will receive a 60-day supply of the drug. If the Food and

Drug Administration deems a medication on our drug list to be unsafe or the drug's manufacturer removes the drug from the market, we will promptly remove the medication from our drug list and provide notice to members who take the drug.

## **How do I use the drug list?**

There are two ways to find your medication within the drug list:

**Medical Condition:** The drug list begins on page 1. The drugs in this list are grouped into categories, depending on the type of medical conditions they are typically used to treat. For example, drugs used to treat a heart condition are listed under the category, "Cardiovascular Agents." If you know what your drug is used for, look for the category name in the list that begins on page 1. Then look under the category name for your drug.

**Alphabetical Listing:** If you are not sure which category to look under, you should look for your drug in the Index that begins on page 12. The Index provides an alphabetical list of all drugs included in this document. Both brand-name and generic drugs are listed in the Index. Look in the Index and find your drug. Next to your drug, you will see the Therapeutic Class where you can find coverage information. Turn to the Therapeutic Class listed in the Index and find the name of your drug in the first column.

## How much will I pay for Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia covered drugs?

If you qualified for extra help with your drug costs, your drug costs may be different than those described below. Please refer to your Evidence of Coverage or call Customer Service to find out what your costs are. After you meet your yearly deductible (if applicable), Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia will pay part of the costs for your covered drugs and you will pay part. The amount you pay depends on which drug tier your drug is in under

our plan and whether you fill your prescription at a preferred network pharmacy. (You can find out which drug tier your drug is in by looking in the drug list that begins on page 1. You will pay the copayment amount for your drugs until your total drug costs (amount you paid including the deductible, if applicable, plus the amount Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia has paid) reach \$2,250. The following chart shows how much you will pay, depending on your plan, once this \$2,250 threshold is reached.

Threshold	SmartValue Plus You Pay
Cost for annual covered eligible prescription drug costs between \$2,250 and \$3,600 out-of-pocket.	100% of the cost
After \$3,600 in annual out-of-pocket costs for covered eligible prescription drugs.	You pay the greater of: - \$2 for generic or preferred brand drug that is a multi-source drug and \$5 for all other drugs, or - 5% coinsurance.

You can ask Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia to make an exception to your drug's tier placement. See the section, "How do I request an exception to the List of Covered Drugs?" for information about how to request an exception.

## Are there any other restrictions on coverage?

Some covered drugs may have additional requirements or limits of coverage. These requirements and limits may include:

- **Prior Authorization:** Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia requires you to get prior authorization in order to access benefits for certain drugs. (You may need prior authorization for medications on the drug list or drugs that are not on the drug list and were approved for coverage through our exceptions process.) This means you will need to get approval from Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia before you fill your prescriptions. If you don't get approval, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia may not cover the drug.

- **Quantity Limits:** For certain drugs, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia limits the amount of the drug that SmartValue Plus will cover. For example, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia provides [4 tablets (35mg) or 30 tablets (5mg or 30mg)] per prescription for Actonel. This may be in addition to a standard 30 or 90-day supply. You can find out if your drug has any additional requirements or limits by looking in the drug list that begins on page 1. You can ask Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia to make an exception to these restrictions or limits. See the "How do I request an exception to the drug list?" section below for information on how to request an exception.

## What if my drug is not on the drug list?

If your drug is not included in this drug list, you should first contact Customer Service and ask if your drug is covered. You can contact Customer Service at 1-866-865-9329, Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Eastern. TTY/TDD users should call 1-888-844-5530. If you learn that Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia does not cover your drug, you have two options:

- You can ask Customer Service for a list of similar drugs that are covered by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia. When you receive the list, show it to your doctor and ask him or her to prescribe a similar drug that is covered by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia.
- You can ask Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia to make an exception and cover your drug. See below for information about how to request an exception.

## How do I request an exception to the drug list?

You can ask Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia to make an exception to our coverage rules. There are several types of exceptions you can ask us to make.

- You can ask us to cover your medication, even if it is not on our drug list.
- You can ask us to waive coverage restrictions or limits on your drug. For example, for certain drugs, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia limits the amount of the drug that we will cover. If your drug has a quantity limit, you can ask us to waive the limit and cover more.
- You can ask us to provide a higher level of coverage for your drug. For example, if your drug is usually considered a Tier 3 drug, you can ask us to cover it as a Tier 2 instead. This would lower the amount you must pay for your drug. Please note, if we grant your request to cover a medication that is not on our drug list, you may not ask us to provide a higher level of coverage for the drug.

Generally, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia will only approve your request for an exception if the alternative medication is included on the plan's drug list, the low-tiered drug or additional utilization restrictions would not be as effective in treating your condition and/or would cause you to have adverse medical effects. You should contact us to ask for an initial coverage decision for a drug list, tiering or utilization restriction exception. When you are requesting a drug list, tiering or utilization restriction exception, you should submit a statement from your physician supporting your request. Generally, we must make our decision within 72 hours of your request.

## What are generic drugs?

Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia covers both brand-name and generic drugs. A generic drug has the same active ingredient formula as the brand name drug. Generic drugs usually cost less than brand name drugs and are approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Generic drugs are listed in lowercase italics (e.g. *digoxin*) within the drug list on page 1. Brand-name drugs are capitalized in the drug list (e.g. LIPITOR).

## Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia's Drug List

The following drug list provides coverage information about the drugs covered by Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia. If you have trouble finding your drug in the list, turn to the Index that begins on page 12.

**Column 1** lists the drug names. Brand name drugs are capitalized (e.g. LIPITOR) and generic drugs are listed in lower-case italics (e.g. *digoxin*).

**Column 2** identifies the coverage level or tier placement of each medication. Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia has a tiered drug list, which means your copayment is generally lower for generic and higher for brand medications.

**Column 3** tells you if there are any special requirements or limits for coverage of your drug. For example:

**QL – Quantity Limits:** restricts the amount of medication for which you can obtain benefits during a specific period of time (most often set on a monthly basis).

**PA – Prior Authorization:** the process of obtaining approval before benefits for certain prescriptions may be approved. If you believe you should receive an exception to these requirements, please ask your pharmacist to contact us at 1-800-203-0267. If more information is needed, we may contact your physician and engage your health plan.

### Important Notes

When you visit a non-network pharmacy, you will be responsible for the difference between the network and non-network pharmacy costs, in addition to your copayment or coinsurance. This does not apply in emergency situations, or when you do not have adequate access to a network retail pharmacy. Additionally, many prescription drugs are available in cost-saving 90-day supplies, when appropriate. We offer benefits that cover 90-day supplies through Preferred Mail Order Pharmacies, or Retail 90-day Pharmacies, who have agreed to dispense an extended supply.

The following table helps explain the copayment amount associated with each tier:

<b>Tier 3</b> Network & Non-Network <b>Non-Formulary</b> (not on list) <b>Brand</b>	No coverage
<b>Tier 4</b> Network & Non-Network <b>Non-specialty Injectables</b>	30-day: 25% Retail 90-day: 25% Preferred Mail Order: 25%
<b>Tier 5</b> Network & Non-Network <b>Specialty Injectables</b>	30-day: 25% Retail 90-day: 25% Preferred Mail Order: 25%
